

Chapter 96 - Billiard Parlors, Pool Rooms

1. No person, firm or corporation, that owns or controls the premises where a coin-operated amusement device as defined in Chapter 97, or similar devices, billiard tables, pool tables or bowling alleys are located, shall permit the use or occupancy of those premises for gambling.
2. No person, firm or corporation shall establish, maintain or operate within the City of Troy, any coin-operated amusement device or devices, billiard parlors, pool rooms or bowling alley, without first obtaining a license in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 59 and Chapter 68 and Chapter 97 of this Code and it shall be unlawful to establish, maintain or operate any of the foregoing without obtaining the license. The fee for the license shall be as specified in Chapter 60 of this Code.
3. No licensee shall permit any person to remain on the licensed premises who is nude, which means less than completely and opaquely covered human genitals, pubic regions, buttocks, and human female breasts below a point above the top of the areola or the covered human male genitals in a visibly turgid state.
